

USEFUL INFORMATION ABOUT THE DIGITAL REPOSITORIES MANAGED BY THE RESEARCH UNIT – CRAI

1) DISSEMINATION AND PRESERVATION CONDITIONS OF THE INSTITUTIONAL REPOSITORY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF BARCELONA AND THE TDX THESIS REPOSITORY

- TDX (Tesis Doctorals en Xarxa) is a cooperative repository managed and coordinated by the Consorci de Biblioteques Universitàries de Catalunya (CBUC) and the Centre de Serveis Científics i Acadèmics de Catalunya (CESCA) containing, in digital format, the doctoral theses read at the universities of Catalonia and other Autonomous Communities.
- The TDX repository is part of the international network Networked Digital Library of Theses and
 Dissertations (NDLTD) whose purpose is to promote the creation, use, dissemination and preservation of
 electronic theses.
- The University of Barcelona is the interlocutor with the CBUC and CESCA for all doctoral theses read at this
 institution that are published in the TDX repository and is in charge of publishing them.
- The consultation of the works deposited in the institutional repository of the University of Barcelona (http://diposit.ub.edu) and the consortium repository of TDX theses (http://www.tdx.cat) is freely accessible, but its use is determined by the conditions of dissemination, that is, with all rights reserved or through Creative Commons licenses. These licenses do not exclude that the original author or author of the work can commercialize it freely, in accordance with current legislation, since the ownership of the moral and exploitation rights over the work belong and will continue to belong to the author or author.
- The University of Barcelona reserves the right to revoke the disclosure of a work in the aforementioned repositories when it deems appropriate for justified reasons, for example if a third party makes any right prevail over all or part of the work and the author/author. The author cannot guarantee the peaceful exercise of the rights that she has assigned to the University. The author/author and the University mutually agree to communicate the existence of any claim by a third party related to the work.
- The University of Barcelona will only make the work available to its users under the conditions established
 in the dissemination license chosen by the author or author, but does not guarantee or assume any
 responsibility for the way in which users make subsequent use of the work.
- The University of Barcelona is not obliged to disclose all the works received in the repositories; In addition, if an error is detected, the material will be returned to the authors so that they can make the appropriate modifications.
- The University of Barcelona undertakes to preserve, whenever possible, all the works deposited in accordance with the format support policy adopted by the Digital Repository. For its part, TDX incorporates different preservation measures to ensure that the theses it includes do not suffer any damage both from their use and from possible natural disasters.
- The contents hosted in the institutional repository of the UB and the TDX repository are indexed by other
 providers through the OAI-PMH protocol (Open Archives Initiative-Protocol for Metadata Harvesting)
 increasing their visibility and search.



2) GUIDELINES FOR CHOOSING THE MODALITY OF COPYRIGHT DEFENSE

Every AUTHOR of a THESIS has some intellectual property rights over it, which he can exercise in the way he deems appropriate to defend his interests. When authorizing the dissemination of the THESIS through the digital repository of the UB and the TDX consortium repository, the AUTHOR can choose between one of these modalities:

- 1. "With all rights reserved". Any person who wishes to make eventual use of the THESIS must request express permission from the AUTHOR, except in the cases provided for by Law (such as private copying or the right to quote).
- 2. Reserving only a part of the rights through a Creative Commons license. It is a licensing system widely disseminated internationally and that allows the reproduction, distribution and public communication of the THESIS, as long as the authorship is acknowledged. By choosing one of these licenses, the AUTHOR allows certain uses without the need for an express request. It is important to note that requesting them is completely free and it is not necessary to register the THESIS in any specific Creative Commons digital repository. On the Creative Commons website (https://creativecommons.org/share-your-work/)there is a tutorial program that facilitates the choice of the most appropriate license for the interests of the AUTHOR.

The current licenses are as follows:

- **Attribution (cc by):** This license allows reusers to distribute, remix, adapt, and build upon the material in any medium or format, so long as attribution is given to the creator. The license allows for commercial use.
- **Attribution-Non Commercial (by-nc):** This license allows reusers to distribute, remix, adapt, and build upon the material in any medium or format for noncommercial purposes only, and only so long as attribution is given to the creator.
- **Attribution-Non Commercial-Share Alike (by-nc-sa):** This license allows reusers to distribute, remix, adapt, and build upon the material in any medium or format for noncommercial purposes only, and only so long as attribution is given to the creator. If you remix, adapt, or build upon the material, you must license the modified material under identical terms.
- **Attribution-Non Commercial-No derivatives (by-nc-nd):** This license allows reusers to copy and distribute the material in any medium or format in unadapted form only, for noncommercial purposes only, and only so long as attribution is given to the creator.
- Attribution Share Alike (by-sa): This license allows reusers to distribute, remix, adapt, and build upon the material in any medium or format, so long as attribution is given to the creator. The license allows for commercial use. If you remix, adapt, or build upon the material, you must license the modified material under identical terms.
- **Attribution No Derivatives (by-nd):** This license allows reusers to copy and distribute the material in any medium or format in unadapted form only, and only so long as attribution is given to the creator. The license allows for commercial use.

The choice of any of these possibilities by the AUTHOR will be expressly stated in the authorization document, indicating **ONLY ONE** of the boxes provided for this purpose.
